RULES & INFORMATION SHEET

1. Entries will be accepted beginning Friday and Saturday night at 5:30pm in the animal show barn.
2. Entry Form will not be accepted without (1) CONTESTANT WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM, (2) ENTRY FEE of \$10.00 and (3) **THE CONTESTANT NEEDS TO WEIGH-IN AT THE FAIR OFFICE WHEN THE ENTRY FORM IS TURNED IN.**
3. "Top 15" entry fees are non-refundable!
4. The first 15 entries ("Top 15") will be accepted per night. Mutton Busters will ride Friday and Saturday nights. **CHOICE OF RIDE NIGHT WILL BE ON 1ST COME 1ST SERVED BASIS.**
5. Weight limit is 50 lbs. on day of Weigh-In
6. **All entries must weigh-in or will be disqualified from participating.**
7. No youth under three (3) years of age or over the age of seven (7) years of age will be allowed to ride.
8. You must report to the **Arena seating area (general admission section) no later than 6:10p.m.** on the night of the ride. A Contestant Number will be issued at that time and must be worn during the entire event.
9. Winning contestants from Friday nights performance must return to the Saturday performance to compete against Saturday's winner for the champion title and belt buckle.
10. Helmets will be provided and are **MANDATORY**. You may bring your own bicycle helmet.
11. Long sleeve shirts and pants are recommended.
12. No substitute riders will be allowed. No refunds in the event your participant chooses not to ride for any reason.
13. No parents are allowed in the arena.
14. No ropes or spurs.

The UNDERSIGNED hereby represent and warrant that they are the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the Minor CONTESTANT named above and that they have the full power, authority, capacity and right, without limitation, to execute, deliver and perform this Release.

Request to Participant. The UNDERSIGNED hereby request that the MINOR CONTESTANT be granted permission to enter the restricted areas and participate as a contestant in the MUTTON BUSTIN' competition (hereinafter referred to as "Event").

Consideration. In consideration of MINOR CONTESTANT being allowed to participate in the event, the UNDERSIGNED hereby agree to the terms of this Contestant Waiver and Release Form.

Acknowledgment of Risk. The UNDERSIGNED understand and acknowledge that rodeos and related livestock events are dangerous activities and that participation in a rodeo or related livestock event exposes the participant to a substantial and serious hazard which may result in property damage and/or personal injury or death. The UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledge that the participation of the above named MINOR CONTESTANT will expose the MINOR CONTESTANT to such hazards.

Release of Sponsor. The UNDERSIGNED, being fully aware that participation by the above named MINOR CONTESTANT in the Event will expose the MINOR CONTESTANT to a substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death, hereby releases sponsors and the Calhoun County Fair Association (hereinafter "RELEASEES"), from liability, and waives the right to sue, for any and all property damage and/or personal injuries or death, or other claims arising from the above named MINOR CONTESTANT'S participation in the Event, even if the property damage and/or personal injury or death is determined to have resulted from the negligent acts or omissions of the RELEASEES.

Covenant Not to Sue. The UNDERSIGNED covenant that they shall not now or at any time in the future, directly or indirectly, commence or prosecute any action, suit or other proceeding against the RELEASEES, their officers, directors, employees, agents, assigns or affiliates for damages of any type arising from participation of the above named MINOR CONTESTANT in the Event, whether such claims be for the benefit of the UNDERSIGNED or of the MINOR CONTESTANT.

Indemnification. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the UNDERSIGNED hereby agree to defend and indemnify and to hold RELEASEE(S) harmless from any liability, claims, demands, causes of action, loss and/or damage arising from participation of the above named MINOR CONTESTANT in the Event, even if caused by the negligent acts or omissions of any of the RELEASEE(S).

We have read this Document; we understand it is a release of all claims. We appreciate and assume all risks inherent in this event.
